

VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

Parent, Caregiver and Community Member,

Volunteers can make a significant contribution to the school community by giving their time and sharing their skills and expertise with others. Volunteers' interests and abilities complement school programs and provide a wide range of interactions and experiences to support student engagement in school and learning.

If you are interested in becoming a volunteer at Meadows Primary School, we encourage you to fill out the application form and complete the necessary training to be recognised as a certified volunteer. As you can appreciate, for the safety of students, we must be thorough with our processes regarding volunteers on the school site.

A volunteer's suitability to contribute to the school is assessed using a screening process. This assessment is made in relation to the skills and contributions being offered after checks with referees, and attempts to match volunteer interests and skills with the needs of the school.

Volunteers are required to:

- complete a working with children screening
- complete the volunteer application form
- participate in *Responding to Abuse and Neglect—Education and Care Induction for Volunteers (RAN-EC Induction)* at the following website and bring completion certificate into school:
